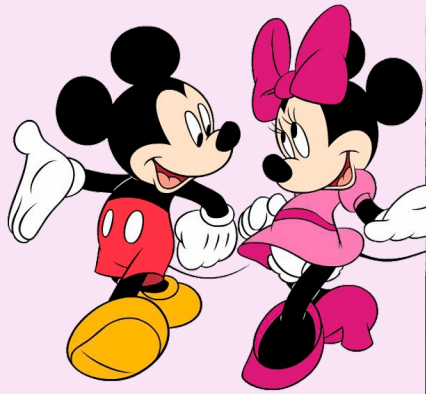

## **GENESIS 5**

<sup>21</sup> When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. <sup>22</sup> After he became the father of Methuselah, ***Enoch walked faithfully with God*** 300 years and had other sons and daughters. <sup>23</sup> Altogether, Enoch lived a total of 365 years. <sup>24</sup> ***Enoch walked faithfully with God; then he was no more, because God took him away.***

## **2 KINGS 2: 11 - 12**

**11** As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and ***Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.*** **12** Elisha saw this and cried out, “My father! My father! The chariots and horsemen of Israel!” ***And Elisha saw him no more.*** Then he took hold of his garment and tore it in two.

## **EXODUS 3**

Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to **Horeb, the mountain of God.**<sup>2</sup> There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up.<sup>3</sup> So Moses thought, “I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up.”

**4** When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, **God called to him from within the bush, “Moses! Moses!”**

And Moses said, “Here I am.”

**5** “Do not come any closer,” God said.

**“Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.”** **6** Then he said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob.” At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God.
